Coppell Gymnasts Bring Home Medals From the State Games of America

COPPELL – Eight local gymnasts from EveryBody Fits traveled to Colorado to compete in the State Games of America, August 2-5, 2007. Daniell Lowry, Level 4, received the silver medal on beam with a 9.575 and had the second highest beam score out of all age divisions. Megan Montgomery received the Bronze medal on bars. Three places - Gold, Silver, and Bronze - were given for each event.

The competing athletes representing the Texas Dreams Gymnastics TAAF team from EveryBody Fits were Daniell Lowry, Kristen Anderson, Alyssa Lowry, Sarah Hayes, Victoria Clark, Jackie Clark, Christa Nied, and Megan Montgomery.

The State Games of America is a multisport event for athletes of all ages and abilities and is held every biennium. In 2006, more than 500,000 athletes competed in State Games nationwide. The State Games feature various sports of the Olympic and Pan American Games.

More than 10, 000 athletes from 47 states representing 29 sports joined to watch Olympic Medalist and World Champion Figure skater, Michelle Kwan, light the Games' Torch. The U.S. Air Force Academy was the primary venue with competition also taking place at the U.S. Olympic Training Center.

The Texas Dreams Gymnastics TAAF team is already looking forward to returning to Colorado Springs, CO for the 2009 State Games of America.
